PAYMENT OF FEES AND DEPOSITS

Registration Fee

A fee of £50 is payable with the Registration Form.

Confirmation of Place Deposit

A non-refundable deposit of one half of the first term's fees will be required to confirm your daughter's place. This Deposit is off-set against the first term's account, and is payable one month after registration or at the beginning of the year of enrolment.

Increases

The Council (The School's Governing body) reviews fees and deposits from September each year.

Settlement of Accounts

Fees are payable in advance on or before the first day of term. The Council reserves the right to impose a 2% surcharge per month on overdue accounts and/or refuse to accept a pupil if the account has not been paid.

Payment by School Fees Plan

We do offer a system of monthly payments through School Fees Plan. Full details are available from the School Accountant.

Refundable Deposit - Overseas pupils

Parents resident outside the United Kingdom will normally be required to deposit a sum of £1,500 with the School.

Refundable Deposit - UK based pupils

Parents resident in the United Kingdom will be required to deposit the sum of £500.

In both cases, the refundable deposit is credited on the pupil's final account on her leaving school.

Linen

A single charge of £25 is made for boarders.

Extra Charges (Charged in arrears)

The School's Policy is to charge an all-inclusive fee for curricular tuition, meals, and boarding (if relevant). Any 'extras' that are charged would be individually incurred personal costs such as the following:

Personal Expenses: eg materials consumed in activities, retained textbooks, concerts, visits, travel costs, medicines, special nursing, special diets, personal laundry, examination fees etc.

Optional Subjects: Optional subjects are charged at the rates shown on the Fee Sheet. **NB:** When discontinuing an optional subject, a term's notice is required, otherwise fees in lieu of notice may be charged.

Advance Payment of Fees

Lump sums deposited in advance can earn tax free interest. Details available from the Bursar.

Optional Charges

The following optional charges automatically appear on all accounts:

- Subscription to Moira House Association
- Personal Accident Insurance
- Fees Refund Scheme
- BUPA Health Insurance (Boarders only)
- Personal Effects Insurance (Boarders only)
- Moira House Old Girls Club (MHOGC). A small termly charge gives life membership.

Parents may delete any of the above options if not required.

Travel Insurance

An annual charge of £4 is made for Seniors and £2 charge for Juniors. This automatically covers students for any School expeditions in the UK or Worldwide.

Details of Optional charges and Travel Insurance are available from the School Accountant.
