
Sun Cream Policy

When the weather starts to get hotter, we ask the parents to bring in named sun cream and sun hats. When they have brought in the cream we ask that they sign a consent form permitting the nursery staff to apply it.

All children **MUST** have a hat on when going outside and if a consent form has been signed then they **MUST** have cream on as well.

When we apply sun cream to the children, we do so in the corridor with another member of staff present. For the older girls we will dollop cream onto the child and they can then rub it in themselves.

If a child does not have their own sun cream at nursery then they will either have to stay indoors with a member of staff or come outside wearing long sleeved t-shirts and long trousers and will have to remain in the shade.
