

This policy is for the whole school including the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS).

An essential part of our educational policy at Roedean Moira House includes the value we place on the development of talents and interests through our wide-ranging activity programme.

Our experience over many years is that every girl is good at something and usually keen to develop a wide variety of skills and interests. This contributes enormously to the growth of confidence and self-assurance of each individual.

A list of the activities for each term can be found in the 'White Book' where possible. Where activities involve an additional cost, parents are made aware of the costs prior to selecting the activity.

The Activities Coordinator is responsible for ensuring the organisation and smooth running of the programme and for updating PASS with the list of activities as well as assigning students to those activities on PASS.

Junior School

During the week a range of activities are on offer. These include drama, dance, crafts, and a variety of musical and sporting activities.

All activities take place in the Junior activity time at 3.05pm.

Seniors and Sixth Form

Every day there is an extensive range of activities on offer as well as drama, music and sports.

Some of the activities are based at school, whilst others take girls into the local community. Our links with care homes, local businesses and other sporting venues continue to grow.

During the week day, activities take place between 4.05 and 5.15pm. Others occur before school, evenings and weekends.

All girls choose from a list of activities each term. Years 6 to 9 are expected to take part in an activity each day, Year 10 a minimum of four activities per week, and Years 11 to 13 are expected to take part in at least three activities each week. If a student regularly participates in activities outside of School they may reduce this by negotiation with their Head of Section.
