

This policy is for the whole school including the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS).

Photography/Videotape/Filing

At Roedean Moira House we are very proud of the achievements made by our girls, and we are very active in promoting our successes.

There has been a recent move to change legislation with regard to the use of photographs in the public domain and consent must now be obtained for their use.

As a result, we require parental/guardianship consent to make use of any photographs for the purpose of reflecting school life, be it a musical event, sports activity, school play, outstanding individual achievements or just everyday life at Moira House.

As speed can often be of the essence, particularly in the case of press releases, we ask all parents and guardians in advance for their blanket consent.

We know that parents are proud when their child is featured.

Swimming Pool

For both the protection of pool users and staff the following rules apply:

- photographs of anyone swimming in the pool may only be taken with the express permission of the Pool Manager.
- Members of the public, members of staff and students may not use cameras, mobiles or any other device capable of capturing a still or moving image to take photographs of girls or staff unless permission has been sought from these people in advance. Members of the public seen using any type of camera in school will have this policy explained to them and will be asked to delete any photographs taken and to put the photographic equipment away.
