EAL CHARGES

English as an Additional Language **group lessons** if required, £1380

This compulsory charge is for international students who are unable to access the normal curriculum due to their level of English. An assessment by the School will be carried out on arrival.

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

Once a place in the School has been accepted, at least one full term's notice of withdrawal of a pupil must be given to the Head in writing, irrespective of whether the pupil has joined the School or not. If the required notice is not given, fees for the next term will be charged.

SETTLEMENT OF ACCOUNTS

Fees are payable in advance on or before the first day of term. The Council (the School's Governing Body) reserves the right to impose a 2% surcharge per month on overdue accounts and/or refuse to accept a pupil if the account has not been paid.

COMPULSORY CHARGES

These are charged in advance where possible. Charges are made to reflect the costs incurred by the School for examination entry, administration and invigilation.

SCHOLARSHIPS AND BURSARIES

A limited number of Scholarships and Bursaries are available each year. Application deadlines are in October for Sixth Form and November for years 3, 7 and 9. Practical assessments are in November for Sixth Form and January for lower years, with offers made the following month. Scholarships are worth a fee reduction of 5-50% and all are awarded based on the performance in the entrance tests, assessments (if relevant) and an interview. A small number of means-tested Academic Scholarships are also available to the value of 50%-80% to girls from the state sector in the top 2% of their class for English and Maths.

SIBLING DISCOUNT

A 5% discount is available on all tuition fees for the second and any subsequent sibling (applicable to pupils in Reception and above).
